When people save animals, especially when they are hurting and can't ask for help, our faith in humanity and mortality is restored. It's refreshing to see a little act of kindness, which is often unsolicited. Dr Ketan Desai, Mr. Viraj looks at an unconscious cow on the side of a road, which is around 15 km away from the city. They got a cow with them in a safe side to get her treated. TGGF, as the cow was in an accident of food poisoning and was in a serious condition. It was heart-warming to see all of the efforts they made to save a life. Truly infuse the infusion drips in the body to hydrate, get medicated after getting fresh by bath and then she feels refreshing. We save her from danger, true benevolence or compassion, extends itself through the whole of existence and sympathizes with the distress of every creature capable of sensation.

## Rescue 4

A day after diwali a person called from sargasan at 4:00am morning. Saying that one mother dog was dead by hit by car and new born babies of mother dog is need for help, due to winter we reach their immediately and get their babies at our center. After that we give heat therapy and give feed of cow milk to them. The team was kind enough to accompany on their holiday, as they understood the situation, special thanks to nishant bhavsar and team to call us on time. Due to him our team were happy to help a newborn babies on this new year's auspicious day.



## Our programme

The God's Gift Foundation programme is an effective, proven way to save animals by providing aids to injured animals. We carefully monitor the programme and its effects. We have recently conducted a program of wheelchairs, sweaters, providing shelter to new borns, and provide other nerve supplements to the animals to protect them from the injuries and heal better. We have conducted the one street dog project who is physically injured by spinal nerve damage, but we decided to treat him. We reach them and give supportive drugs to them and we make a wheelchair for him. He is only 60 days old. We feel so bad, after a more effort we treat him. But we realized that the street dog population is high and that the death proportion ratio is approx 70% of total. Our programme is a successful. Nationally recognized and one of the best examples for saving animals from humans.



## Regular feeding

We all understand very well that the necessities of life are air, water and food. However people do not understand the importance of it. Just as it is a vital thing for you. There are many creatures on earth who deserve food, shelter, support of human being, because no one can understand their unbounding love toward us. With a new idea our team TGGF work daily for abol jiv, Therefore, regular feeding. Even one time meal a day is enough to keep them alive, in the spirit of abol jeev bachao, we feed about 400 street animals a day.

We reached their in early morning and take care of him, give iv Infusions and injection for stable, also give nutritive therapy to improve his health.
